Score 6.0/10

Richard □ Hand raised, small & pastry to meat ratio meant too much pastry. Lovely meat,

fresh, granular, nice peppery spices.

Score 7.0/10

Kevin □ Old fashioned appearance, thick nutty crispy pastry, solid tasty jelly, granular spicy meat with lots of afterburn. Fresh, really enjoyed it.

Score 9.0/10

Bruce □ Hand raised good looking pie but a bit on the small size. Crispy, crunchy pastry but a little dry. The meat was very compact, very tasty and nice spices and lots of afterburn.
